Football Player's /Cheerleader's / Coach's must be participating in a game at the specific site for free entry at the site and he/she must be on OFFICIAL GAME ROSTER.

Coaches must bring Munchie Game Day Rosters.

Game Attire:

- **Cheerleaders:** are expected to wear their Jamz Camp attire.
- **Football players:** Practice gear only. Cleats are required for all football players.
- **Coaches:** may wear their team attire.

Arrival Time:

Gates open at 6:30am.

All participants are asked to arrive no less than 1 hour before their scheduled game.

Medical Paperwork:

Each Head Coach is expected to have a duplicate binder on site with all medical release forms. The form is required to accompany any child being transported by ambulance.

Water & Ice:

There will be NO ice available on site. Plan ahead and bring ice if you need it. Head Coaches are allowed to bring in one ice chest per level with water and fruit.

Food:

NO outside food or drinks! (Morning Coffee drinks will be allowed until 9 a.m.)
There will be food, drinks and snacks for sale. Special dietary needs should be addressed with your Team League Rep before game day.

Chairs and Pop-ups are allowed:

Placement should be at least 20 feet from the sidelines.

Pets:

NO pets allowed.

Game Format:

- All four levels of participation (football and cheer) shall compete in this pre-season TVYFL event.
- No blitz
 - No playing both ways in the same half (1/2 offense and 1/2 defense)
- All offensive plays begin from a huddle on the field.
- Format follows
 - 15 minutes of play – a 5-minute break – 15 minutes of play
 - This is a running clock scrimmage with coaches officiating (with whistles).

The Munchie Name:

Honoring Ryan "Munchie Taylor"

Prior to the 2004 season, the Munchie Games were called "Round Robin". On July 12, 2004, a motorcycle accident claimed the life of former Saints' player and coach Ryan "Munchie" Taylor. In 2003, Munchie was the youngest certified coach in the history of the Trans Valley Youth Football League coaching alongside his dad, Dave Taylor. His younger brother Brent, played his final year as a "Saint" in 2007 and was the last person that will ever wear the number 51 within the Saints. The number 51 jersey was worn by Munchie as a player and was officially retired at the end of the 2007 season. In memory of Munchie, the TVYFL respectfully changed the name to the "Munchie Games".
